## PGE Electrical Work at New Columbia

Portland General Electric will be adding new wires and transformers to the utility poles along Woolsey Avenue to provide enough electricity for the future New Columbia housing. These new improvements will follow Woolsey Avenue from Houghton Street to Willis Boulevard. PGE's work will not disrupt power service to current residents in the neighborhood.

This work will require occasional fence openings at Woolsey to allow delivery of materials and passage of PGE personnel. These fence openings are scheduled to begin on Tuesday, June 15th. PGE expects the entire overhead project will be complete by the middle of July. PGE will begin their work at the Houghton Street connection to shorten the potential period for fence openings.
